Dear Group Members:

On behalf of the Waco Metropolitan Area Regional Sewer System (WMARSS), the City of Waco is requesting a minor amendment to the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan to incorporate specific direct reuse projects in McLennan County. Section 4C.38.17.2: of the 2006 Plan recommended the following "water supply plan" for the City of Waco: "Develop Reuse Supplies to Extend Lake Waco and Trinity Aquifer Supplies." In making this recommendation, the Group specifically recommended that Waco "continue to pursue direct and indirect reuse as a water management strategy in order to diversify and extend regional water supplies in the McLennan County area." The projects that will form the basis for the amendment will specifically:


Conserve valuable and highly stressed surface and groundwater supplies  
Make potable water supplies available for future growth  
Allow us to meet 2060 demands

The WMARSS includes the cities of Bellmead, Hewitt, Lacy Lakeview, Lorena, Robinson, Waco, and Woodway, which could all make reuse water available to their citizens and businesses under this initiative.

Waco has retained HDR to prepare the necessary amendment documents for the Group to consider. We request that this item be placed on the agenda for the February meeting to inform the Group of our plans and to ask the Group to consider our amendment request at the April meeting. HDR will have the final amendment materials ready for the Group to consider in early March.

The WMARSS cities would appreciate your support for this amendment.
